

Content Search

socialprotection.org invites agencies, governmental and non-governmental organisations, research centres, think tanks and individuals to discover and share content related to social protection.

Each search allows users to explore content—publications, stakeholders, programmes and more—related to social protection through a structured framework, or taxonomy. Any member can share content for which they hold the copyrights, or which is freely available to the public, by uploading it to the platform. All content is then revised and moderated by the **socialprotection.org** team.

The Content Search Filters

The various content search filters are designed to sort source material in the most user-friendly way, by providing an initial keyword search. It is also possible to use multiple filters according to the social protection taxonomy to further refine results:

• Social protection programmes

Search for documents on a particular type of social protection programme.

Social protection topics

Search for documents on a specific subject related to the design, implementation and monitoring of social protection programmes/policies, as well as theoretical and operational approaches to the topic.

• Cross-cutting areas

Search for documents by social areas/policies that can be affected by social protection strategies or that interact with social protection programmes and policies.

Geographic area

Search for documents by country or region of interest.

· Population groups

Search according to the analysed population group(s).

Author/Publisher type

Search documents by the authoring/publishing institution.

Content type

Search according to the purpose of the document (case study, impact evaluation, etc.).

Document type

Search documents by format, including text, video, slides, etc.

Language

Search for documents in a specific language.

Year of publication

Search by year a document was published.
